Checking IN:

- **Boats** can be brought to the Yacht club the night before between 6:30-7:30 pm or the day of the regatta between 8:00 am-9:15am. Most people check in the day of the regatta. People who come the day before usually do so for boat transportation purposes.
- **Registration Table:** Even though you registered you need to come to basically check in.
 - We will have 2 tables
 - **Confirm your sail number**
 - **Receive your lunch wrist bands**
 - **Receive your craft wrist bands**
 - **Sailors receive a gift/giveaway**
 - **This is the best opportunity to make any registration updates.**

Picture Taken of SKIPPERS:

- There will be an Opti set up on land before the races.
- Pictures will be on a table by the craft section DURING/AFTER awards for families to take.
- The pictures of the top 5 places are used for their framed award.

GUESSING JAR

- SKIPPERS ONLY get an opportunity to take a guess at how many candies are in the jar. The winner will be awarded the jar at awards time.

Raffle Table

- NLSS has raffle tickets for sale at the raffle table beginning at 8:30 am and ending at 1:30 pm
- It is basically \$1 per ticket. Most of the items are kid orientated and a lot of fun to win.
- We ask winners to be present at time of awards, or have a representative with their ticket.

RACE RUN DOWN

- SKIPPER MEETING: at 9:35 per NOR
- Actual race start times dependent on Race Committee, but the goal is 10 am.
- JUNIORS sail first
- SENIORS sail after JRs are finished. Verbal announcements to Seniors begin when JRs are sailing back from their race. We use a megaphone and go to the craft tables. SENIORS WILL SAIL 2 RACES.
- JUNIORS come in and begin crafts. JUNIOR will be called to lunch while Seniors are sailing.
- RACE COMMITTEE (RC) comes in to eat lunch after Seniors finish their 2nd race. RC will then give a time for the next JUNIOR race. It will be posted on an announcement board and verbally announced. JUNIORS go out for 2nd race and then Seniors will go out in the same matter as the morning.

CRAFT TABLES

- Included in Sailor registrations and can be purchased separately for siblings that aren't sailing.
- The crafts are set up in the garage, but 'the doors don't open' until the junior fleet goes out for their first race.

LUNCH

- We recommend purchasing your lunches in advance.
- Sailor's lunch is included in registration. Crafter's lunch included in craft fee.
